I hope you received and read the email sent out in May regarding the need for a quorum of 50 at our June and July meetings. As stated in that email, our membership has dropped below 100, and our attendance at our meetings/dances has fallen significantly. Our bylaws say we must have 50 members present to conduct business. The Bylaws Committee feels this needs to be amended to a percentage which would help correct this problem. There are also some other adjustments to the bylaws, including the section on the Hall of Fame, that need to be discussed and reworded.

In order to make these adjustments, we must have 50 members at the meeting where the changes are presented and then at the next meeting to vote on them. The Board did extensive research to verify that using Quorum by Proxy Only forms is an acceptable solution, and based on Robert's Rules of Order, which our bylaws state as the Parliamentary authority, it is an acceptable way to remedy the problem of not having a quorum present at our meetings.

If you are uncertain if you will be at the June or July meeting, please send your signed Quorum by Proxy Only form to the club to arrive before the meeting starts at 7:00 pm on Friday, June 14, 2024. You can mail it back to PO Box 3762, Wilmington, NC 28406, give it to any member to bring to the meeting or scan, sign, and return it by email to Jan Gresham or me. A copy is also attached to this newsletter for your convenience. Please feel free to email, text or call me if you have any questions regarding this procedure.
